Insurance should include the cost of repatriation (assisted transfer of a person back to their home country in case of serious injury or illness). The insurance has to cover the entire period of stay at HEI bréquigny. Incoming students should e-mail a copy of their insurance doc to the Exchange Coordinator, before their mobility period.
